I return herewith the plan, forwarded with Mr. Ormiston's letter of the 24th instant, of bulkheads proposed to be fitted in the yacht "FLYING CLOUD", and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the arrangements of bulkheads be carried out as shown and amended on the plan, and to your satisfaction, the same will be approved.

In view of the upper deck being sheathed with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " teak, the beams at this deck in way of the machinery space may be fitted on alternate frames if desired.

As desired I have wired you to-day as follows, viz:-

FLYING CLOUD

AWCYAACXAD - bulkheads approved provided
AWCYAAWWOX - bulkhead frame
FLUBTFLMT - ~~sixty~~ four
or
FLUBTFLISM - eighty seven
EDSGOAWOPS - carried upper deck
ECVOFBAMET - and tween deck
AWCYAAWWOX - bulkhead frame
FLOJYEKOHM - twenty watertight.
