Dear Sir,

We have to forward for consideration, plan in duplicate showing proposal to operate the Watertight doors in the bulkheads in the above Yacht from positions below the upper deck. A letter received at this Office from Captain Davies, owner's representative is enclosed.

We have to say that we have examined actually on the ship the proposed operating positions of these watertight doors.

The proposed operating positions are close to and accessible to a stairway leading to upper deck in the case of the door on bulkhead at 63 frame and to the engine room entrance in the case of door in bulkhead at 35 frame.

The proposal in our opinion merits favourable consideration in this case.
