M. I return herewith one copy of each of the plans, forwarded with Mr. Robson's letter of the 28th ultimo, showing the arrangement of windows in the passage way through the trunk in the 'tween decks of the "FLYING CLOUD", and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the arrangements be carried out as shown and amended and to your satisfaction, they will be approved.

It is not considered necessary that dead plates should be fitted covering the glass windows, provided the latter and their frames be efficiently bedded to your satisfaction.

It is noted that the entrance to the machinery space is intended to be made from the top of the casing instead of through a watertight door as originally proposed, and it is presumed that revision will be made to render this entrance watertight.

The duplicate plans are being retained.


