Yacht "FLYING CLOUD"

Dear Sir,

With reference to the trunk passage way connecting the Owners' with the guests' accommodation being fitted in the above Yacht, we beg to submit for consideration two plans in duplicate showing the detail and position of the rectangular windows to be fitted on each side of the watertight trunk passage way.

It is observed from the plan that there is no provision for dead plates covering the glass windows and we shall be glad to know if it is considered necessary to fit them in this case.

Regarding your letter of the 15th September 1925, we have to state that the proposal to fit a watertight door on the starboard side of the passage has been abandoned, the entrance to the machinery space being from the top of the casing at the side of the watertight passage way. The scantlings of the trunkway appear to be satisfactory.
