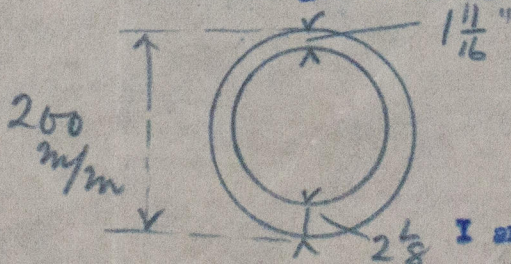
Tensile test - Tons per sq. inch - 34

Extension - 28.9%

Cold bend test - 180° - without fracture-
