M. I duly received Mr. Ormiston's letter of the 12th instant enclosing a plan (in duplicate) of cast steel stern tube for the Steel Twin Screw Yacht "FLYING CLOUD", and I have to observe that while the arrangement in regard to the casting could be recommended for approval, the method by which it is fixed into the structure of the vessel is not shown in sufficient detail to enable consideration to be given thereto.

I have therefore to state that the proposed arrangement of stern tube could be approved, provided the attachment to the structure at the outboard end be to your entire satisfaction, and the arrangements be otherwise as shown on the plan.

One copy of the plan is returned herewith, the duplicate being retained in this Office for record. The three plans forwarded with your letter of the 5th instant are also enclosed.
