Dear Sir,

We have to submit for approval plan (in duplicate) showing proposed arrangement of Casting forming support to shafting where latter leaves the hull and have to state that this Casting is already made.

Your letter of the 10<sup>th</sup> inst regarding the plan of "A" brackets has just now been received.

We would state that when the plan of aft end structure was received on 11<sup>th</sup> March last together with your letter of 8<sup>th</sup> March last. (M) the instructions therein were



immediately transmitted to the builders.

On the occasion of each visit to the builder's yard the necessity for submitting without delay the plans of A brackets and of the Casting now forwarded has been stated to the builders.

The owner's representative, Mr. Barbour has also made requests to the builders, independently to the same effect.

When the builders were first spoken to, regarding the plans in question, they did not inform us that the Castings had been ordered and this came to our knowledge later.
