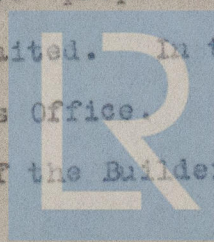
Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant forwarding three plans shewing the attachment of A brackets to the hull structure in the Yacht "FLYING CLOUD", from which it is noted that the shaft brackets are now made.

I shall be glad if you will point out to the Builders that a plan of these brackets was asked for in my letter of the 8th March, when it was made clear on the plans that approval of the shaft brackets was contingent on the receipt of the requested plans, and it is considered that plans should have been submitted as requested.

The arrangements now proposed appear to be substantially the same as originally dealt with on the 8th March and 21st May, which were not approved, and as the attachment of the palms to the hull structure is the crux of the matter, the Builders' proposals thereon (stated to be forthcoming later) are awaited. In the meantime the plans are being retained in this Office.

The attention of the Builders might be further
