I return herewith the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 22nd instant, in connexion with the Steel Yacht "FLYING CLOUD", and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that the proposed arrangement of stern gear will be approved, provided the steel shell plating forming the bossing at the after end of the stern tube, and also the after sides of the cast steel arms of the "A" brackets in way of the propeller blades, be protected by zinc plates, in metallic contact with the steel structure, to your satisfaction.
