Yacht "FLYING CLOUD" . -

We have to forward herewith a tracing plan shewing proposed arrangement of propeller shafting, propellers, propeller brackets and stern tube . -

The proposed arrangement has been discussed with Mr. J.H. Barbour, consulting Naval Architect for the Owner, who has brought the plan to this Office at the request of the Owner and of the Builders . -

The Owner and the Builders would esteem it a favour if the Committee could advise them as to whether the proposed arrangement as shown on the plan is considered a suitable one from the point of view that the shaft and the propeller are of bronze and the stern tube of gunmetal and that these masses of bronze and gunmetal are in proximity to the steel hull, which they think may suffer corrosion on this account . - Also they would be glad to know, with such an arrangement, what (if any) precautions should be taken to cope with any corrosion of the steel hull which might result from the proximity to the steel hull of these masses of bronze and gunmetal . -
