

GASELEE & SON hereby give notice that they will not be answerable to any customer for any loss, damage or delay, which may happen to any barge, vessel or thing towed, or agreed to be towed, on behalf of that customer, or to the cargo of such barge, vessel or thing, or for any expense incurred in relation to such loss, damage or delay, or for loss of life of, or personal injury to, persons on board such barge, vessel or thing, or its cargo, even although such loss, damage, delay, expense, loss of life or personal injury may be caused by defective gear or by the negligence or misconduct of their servants, and the services of their tugs must be understood and agreed to be accepted upon the terms that they are to be held harmless and indemnified by such customer from all claims in respect of the matters and things above-mentioned by whomsoever made, whether arising from defective gear or from the negligence or misconduct of their servants or not. GASELEE & SON may employ a tug of other Owners to do the work, and in any such case the foregoing stipulations are to apply for their protection and indemnification as though the employed tug belonged to them and the men working her were their servants. Tugs may deviate and may take other barges, vessels and things in tow. GASELEE & SON will whenever requested so to do take all necessary steps at their customer's expense to secure statutory limitation of their liability provided they are entitled to claim the protection of the Statute.
