

Steam Tug "CULEX"

Electric light Installation.

The Aberdeen Surveyors now state that the electric light installation has been carried out in accordance with the Requirements of the Rules, except that the Navigation Lights have no indicators.

Further, that the Builders state that these fittings are not necessary in this instance, as the vessel has a small open bridge and the side lights and mast head lights are very close to the steersmans' platform.

Approval was given on the 18th August last to dispensing with the aforementioned fittings in the case of steam trawlers and tugs building by Messrs. Cochrane & Sons Hull, the approval being subject to the Owners' consent being obtained.

It is submitted that in this instance the proposal to dispense with the fitting of Navigation Light Indicators might be approved provided the Owners' consent be obtained.
