Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo, and note that the Owners have agreed to the Electric Light Installation being surveyed on the new steamtug "CULEX" now completing at this port.

The installation generally has been carried out to the Rules except that the navigation lights have no indicators, and it is submitted on behalf of the builders that these are not necessary in this instance, as the vessel has a small open bridge, and the sidelights and mast lead lights are very close to the steersman's platform. I should be glad to have your instructions regarding the matter by telegram as the vessel is expected to sail within the next few days.
