With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "DASHIADA", I beg to acquaint you, that the Committee have had before them to-day a letter addressed to the Society's Glasgow Office by Mr. A.C. Miller, your Consulting Engineer, in which it is stated that you do not desire to continue the classification of the vessel with this Society, and in the circumstances the Committee have given instructions for her class to be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at owners' request.
