I enclose herewith a letter from the Central Marine Engine Works asking for a certificate for the spare propeller of the S. S. "HORDA" supplied when the ship was new in 1920.

I examined the propeller and discussed with the Owner's representative the slight unsoundness of the metal in the bore of the boss and we agreed that it was not of any consequence.

The propeller was generally examined and no other evidence of unsoundness found.

I shall be glad to know if a certificate may be issued stating that this propeller was examined and found sound as far as could be seen, except for a few small blow holes in the bore of the boss which did not effect the efficiency of the propeller.


