H. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 17th instant respecting the tug "C.C.MENGEL JR" and in reply I think it well to enclose herewith for your information an abstract from the Society's Rules giving particulars of the periodical surveys which require to be carried out in order to entitle this vessel to retain her class in the Register Book. As you will observe the Screw Shaft requires to be drawn in for examination at intervals of not more than two years. In the present instance the survey of the shaft became due at the end of July last, and as this inspection is considerably overdue arrangements should be made for it to be held without delay. I shall therefore be obliged if you will kindly let me know as soon as possible, for the information of the Committee, what steps you propose taking in the matter.
