The Second Special Survey No.1, which became due on this steamer in April, 1928, has been partly carried out, but the Owners now state that in view of the small tonnage of the vessel and of the fact that she is employed in coastal service, they do not desire to maintain her classification in the Society's Register Book, and will only retain that of the Registro Italiano in accordance with Italian Law.

In the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Tuesday, 28th instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
