With further reference to your letter of the 2nd ultimo and our reply of the 3rd ultimo, I beg to submit herewith, for the consideration of the Committee, a sketch of the donkey boiler of the above named steamer, there being no makers drawing available.

No information is obtainable concerning the tests of the material.

The boiler has been examined internally and externally and found in good condition, tested by hydraulic pressure to 130 lbs per sq. inch and found good, and the safety valves have been provisionally adjusted to lift at 100 lbs/sq.inch.
