"Owners request you may instruct by cable Society's

The Society's Surveyors at Bordeaux have been advised accordingly by telegram today, and instructed to attend with the object of carrying out the Rule requirements for classification as far as possible, including noting of the scantlings of hull and machinery where this can be done for the compilation of a First Entry Report.

It will greatly facilitate the proposed classification if there are available any detailed plans shewing the scantlings and arrangements of the ship, and I accordingly wired you today as follows:-

- VILLE DE BELFORT
- DEMBOEGBIZ = there are no plans in this Office shewing vessel's scantlings, obtain same from Owners if possible
- EBTIWAJEME = STOP plating must be drilled
- REQUEST
- EHLXAEGRUS = Owners issue
