I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have had before them at their meeting to-day the case of your steamer "TOYEN MARU", together with a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, in which it is stated that in view of the present and future service this vessel will be engaged upon you have decided to withdraw her classification from the Society's Register Book, and I am directed to inform you that in view of this intimation instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
