I beg to acknowledge your letter dated 21st December 1915, concerning my 1st Entry Reports on Vessels "YAQUE" "YUNA" and "INCA".

"YAQUE.54."

Regarding the thickness of the upper deck sheer strake clear of bridge, I may state that thickness of same is <sup>as</sup> approved, and that the tests of the steel wire in the case of this vessel and also the sister Vessels S. S. "YUNA" and "INCA" was 30.7 tons.

"INCA.56. YUNA.55."

I note that the Committee have agreed to accept the third bower anchors of the above vessels.

"YUNA.55."

Regarding the third bower anchor of this Vessel I may state that the builders have ordered a new third Bower anchor, and that they will make arrangements to have same placed on board.

I herewith acknowledge receipt of the certificates of the above three Vessels, and have to inform you that these have been handed to the shipbuilders and that the fees were received and placed to the Society's credit on 25th January 1916.

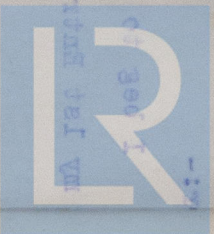
