

The screw shaft survey of this vessel became due in March last and the Annual Boiler Survey in July.

The steamer has recently been transferred to Japanese Ownership, and the new Owners, in a letter dated 29th June, state that she will be employed in Coasting Service and they do not consider it necessary to maintain her in the Society's Classification.

In the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Friday, 26th ultimo, decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
