Nature of Survey When due

This vessel was classed in February 1926 subject to 15 fathoms of chain cable and a stream chain or equivalent steel wire being supplied.

The 2nd S.S. No.1 became due 3,29.

The Susak Surveyor now forwards a letter from the Owners stating that the vessel has been classed with Bureau Veritas and it is not intended to continue the class with this Society.

It is submitted the class of the vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
