Dear Sir,

We are in receipt of your yesterday's cablegram as follows:-

"Sava Referring Ozegovics letter 26th November that  
"cargo battens would be fitted during completion  
"machinery survey forward report on form 8 same time  
"stating whether vessel eligible fresh record survey  
"which otherwise would be March 1925".

Mr. Bonivento stated that on the occasion of his last visit to Split he found that cargo battens had been partly provided for this vessel but not in sufficient number, therefore they were not yet fitted on board at the time. Mr. Bonivento is at present at Split and Dubrovnik and is looking after the case. On his return to this port early next week a full reply will be sent to your above enquiries.
