

With reference to the Classification in this Society's Register Book of the tug "ITAPAGIPE" and to the Special Annual Boiler Survey prescribed by the Society's Rules which became due on this vessel at the end of November last, I beg to acquaint you I am in receipt of a letter from the Owners in which they state that the vessel is now at Bahia where the survey in question can be held.
