The class of this vessel was withdrawn from the Register Book in January last and three dots (...) inserted in lieu.

Subsequently the Owner stated that it was not his intention to withdraw the vessel from class until August of this year.

The case is stated in the endorsements dated 24.1.29, 4.4.29, 8.4.29, and 15.4.29.

Messrs. Macdonald, Bellingham and Olsen, Shipbrokers of this City, now write that in consequence of the vessel having made a voyage from the Gulf of Mexico to the River Plate without a class, the charterers have withheld a portion of the freight money on behalf of the Shipper to cover any eventual additional insurance on the cargo.

Messrs. Macdonald, Bellingham & Olsen ~~now~~ ask on behalf of the Owners of the vessel that the Society should issue a notice that there is no extra insurance involved on cargo for the voyage in order to assist them in recovering the withheld portion of the freight.

IT IS SUBMITTED the writers be informed that the issue of such a notice does not come within the scope of the Society's operations, and in the circumstances it is suggested that a copy of the letter might be forwarded to Lloyd's for their attention.
