Dear Sir,

With reference to the correspondence with your goodself respecting the case of your steamer "ORLA", I beg to acquaint you that a cablegram has now been received from the Society's Surveyors at Buenos Aires, from which it appears that the Master stated that no survey is required for this Society, and in the circumstances I thought it well to send you the following cable, which I now confirm, viz:-
