Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your letter of April 10, 1929, regarding the proposed amendment to the Internal Revenue Code, Chapter 110, Section 1101, relating to the taxation of gifts.

The proposed amendment is as follows:

Section 1101. (a) The term "gift" shall include any property which is transferred by an individual to another individual, and the value of which is determined for the purpose of computing the gift tax.

(b) The term "property" shall include any interest in real or personal property, whether or not such interest is an estate or a right in property, and whether or not such interest is a legal or equitable interest.

(c) The term "individual" shall include any natural person, and any estate, trust, or other entity which is a legal entity under the law of any State or Territory.

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
