I duly received your letter of the 30th ultimo, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Piraeus, respecting the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "PLEIAS", and having submitted the same for the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting to-day, I am directed to acquaint you that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
