Your letter of the 27th November last, addressed to the Society's Surveyor at Seattle, respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Barquentine "FOREST PRIDE", has been forwarded to this Office, and the case has received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting to-day.

The Committee note that until you can find employment for the vessel you are not prepared to carry out the overdue survey, and seeing that this Special Survey became due so long ago as September 1927, they regret that they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book, ^{with a red line} indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

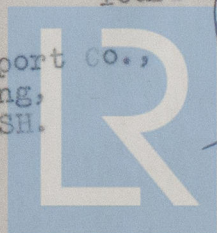
