A Special Survey, equal to a Half Time Survey, became due on this Wood Sailing Vessel in September 1927, and action has been deferred by the Classing Committee from time to time owing to her being laid up, the Owners having furnished the usual undertaking.

In accordance with the practice adopted by the Committee in cases of vessels laid up indefinitely, the Owners were recently requested to arrange for the vessel to be submitted to general examination with a view to the maintenance of her class for a further period of 12 months, but the Seattle Surveyor now forwards a letter received from the Owners Agents, intimating that they are not prepared to incur any expense in connexion with the vessel's classification until they can find employment for her, and that in the meantime they presume she will lose her class.

The case again received the consideration of the Classing Committee on Friday, the 20th December, when instructions were given for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (12-29), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Seattle Surveyor has been requested by cable to inform the Owners accordingly.
