Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your cablegram of the 2nd and 4th instant respecting the Bkn. "FOREST FRIEND" from which it is noted that this vessel has been towed to Vancouver under cover of night without being submitted to Special Survey as required, and I have to say that, in the circumstances the Committee have given instructions for her class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line indicating non-compliance with the Rules.

As there would appear to be no further information regarding the Ownership of the vessel beyond that detailed in your letter of the 17th October last, I enclose herewith a letter to the Owner conveying the Committee's decision to expunge her class, and have to request that you will forward this communication to the Owner or his accredited Agents.
