The Seattle Surveyor now writes as

follows:-

On the 10th of December 1928 upon a signed request of Captain E. L. Tindall, Master of the bark, who brought the vessel in from Australia, I made a preliminary survey while she lay afloat at Winslow, Eagle Harbor, Washington and found that besides other repairs necessary it was my duty to recommend the renewal of the main mizzen and jigger masts, the caulking of the main and quarter decks throughout and renewal of wire stays to bowsprit, also certain repairs to foreyard.


