

Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your barque "FOREST PRIDE", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have today had before them a letter received from the Society's Surveyor at Seattle from which it appears that the vessel is laid up in Lake Union.

In the circumstances I have to say that as the Special Survey equal to a Half Time Survey is now so long overdue the Committee can only agree to her class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for a period of twelve months, subject to the conditions usually required by them in similar cases, viz:- that the overdue survey and all necessary repairs be completed before the vessel again proceeds to sea, and that you undertake to have this done if she remain your property, and should she be offered for sale to inform intending purchasers that the class is allowed to remain subject to this being done.

I shall therefore be glad to learn that you are willing to agree to these conditions, and that you will
