Sir,

With regard to the enquiry in your letter of yesterday's date, relative to the Ownership of the new steel screw steamer "HAZEL DOLLAR", per Grk. report No. 14203, I beg to enclose for your information a letter received from the Builders, Messrs. A. Rodger & Co., explaining the apparent discrepancy, which arose in consequence of the steamer not being able at the moment to be registered in Victoria, B.C. but was temporarily registered in Glasgow, in the name of one of the partners of the Builders, Mr. Hutchison.

Mr. Dollar resides at San Francisco but is compelled by the United States laws to register in Victoria, B.C. or elsewhere outside the United States.

The information given on the First Entry report was furnished by the Builders, who now urge that the certificates be withheld until the vessel has been re-registered by the Hazel Dollar Steam Ship Co., the actual owners, and will advise you in due course ~~as to the record~~ *in the Register Book*.
