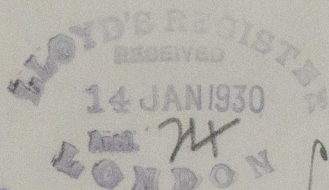

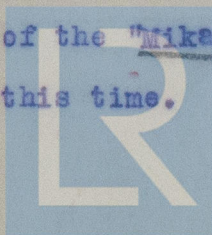

Dear Sir,

I enclose herewith a letter which has been received from Messrs. Muke Kisen Kabushiki Kaisha, in which they state that they desire to withdraw the classification of the above vessels from the Society's Register Book.

In the case of the "Mikage Maru No.11" the 2nd. S.S. No.1 became due in April 1928, and was partly held in December of that year, but at the Owners' request completion of this Survey was specially postponed until this month, i.e. beyond the year of grace, in order that it might be done at the same time as the Government Survey. (See your Classing Letter dated January 11th. 1929). In the circumstances therefore, it is submitted that the class of this vessel be expunged with a red line.

In the case of the "Mikage Maru No.8" no surveys appear to be due at this time.
