I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their Meeting to-day a communication received from the Society's Surveyor at Dairen, from which it appears you have advised him that it is not your desire to maintain the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "CHOJUN MARU", and I am directed to say that in view of the intimation contained in your letter, dated 2nd July last, addressed to the Society's Surveyor at Dairen, the Committee have given instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate, which has been returned to this Office, has accordingly been cancelled.
