Dear Sirs,

I duly received your telegram of the 7th instant which being decoded reads as follows:-

"BURE referring to your letter of 3rd instant Owners request that you should appoint a Surveyor from the London Office to proceed to Las Palmas with steamer "SAN MATEO" which vessel leaving London 11th instant confer with Owners' Agents Fred Dessen & Co.. 6/8 "Lime Street Square".

In reply thereto I am directed to acquaint you that arrangements have been made for Mr. A.A.A. Chalmers, a Surveyor on the London Outdoor Staff, to proceed to Las Palmas as desired and carry out the necessary survey. It is understood from Messrs. Dessen that the "SAN MATEO" will not be leaving London until Monday evening next, 13th instant.

In these circumstances I have wired you today as follows:-
