Sir,

We beg to submit for the consideration of the Committee the test certificates for the anchors and chain cables supplied to Messrs Cochrane & Sons steam trawlers Nos. 380 & 381.

In the case of No.380 it will be seen that the second anchor and stock is 21lbs light. In the case of No.381 the first anchor and stock are 7 lbs heavier, and the second/and stock 21 lbs light. With regard to No.382 for the same Owners, the Builders state that the second anchor is 17 lbs light, but we have not received the certificates for this vessels anchors and cables yet.

We enclose a letter from the builders in reference to these cases together with the approved plans for reference.


