We return herewith the certificate for this anchor, and shall be glad to hear that the matter is now in order.

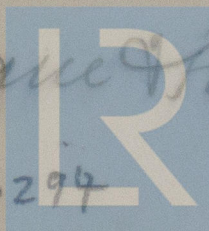
We notice that the same anchor for Nos 381 and 382 are respectively 16 and 17lbs light, and the Owners suggest the same course be adopted with regard to these two.
