I am in receipt of your letter of the 12th instant reporting that this vessel had left the Tyne during the week-end without any action being taken with regard to the completion of the Second Special Survey No.2. The Committee have had the case before them to-day, and in view of the generally poor condition of the vessel as reported in your letter of the 16th instant, they have had no alternative but to give instructions for her class to be expunged with a black line.
