I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 15th instant addressed to them relative to the steamer "MICHAEL", and in confirmation of my telegraphic reply today, as under, I have to say that the Committee cannot agree to any further postponement of the 2nd Special Survey No.2 but must require this inspection to be completed, and all necessary repairs to be effected, before the vessel proceeds to sea in order to entitle her to retain her class in the Register Book.
