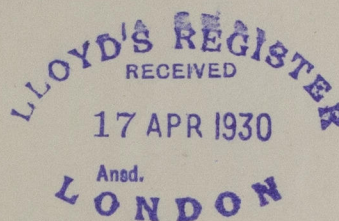

S.S. "MICHAEL".

We beg to forward herewith a letter received today from the Owners of the above steamer.

The vessel has been examined in dry dock, the shell plating drilled and a specification prepared by the Owners' Representative with a view to getting tenders for completion of the Special Survey (2nd No. 3 at the latter's request) commenced in Cardiff in October 1929.

A number of temporary repairs were effected then to the shell plates. These plates and a number of others have now been found, together with other parts of the vessel, to be in a poor condition. It is submitted that the Owners' request for a further postponement of the greater part of the Special Survey which became due in 9-28, be not acceded to, in view of the above remarks and the Secretary's letter to the Owner, sent after the Cardiff examination in October last.
