The Second Special Survey No.2 of this motor barge became due in August last.

In a letter, dated 3rd instant, however, the Owners state that in view of the nature of the service in which the vessel is employed at Kingston, Jamaica, they do not desire to continue her in the Society's Classification.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, 15th instant, and in the circumstances decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
