Nature of Survey _____ When due _____

The 1st S.S. No.3 became due 12.29 and in August last a general examination was made with a view to the postponement of the special survey until April or May last.

The Copenhagen Surveyors stated in April last that in accordance with instructions from the Owners' Superintendent the vessel was being surveyed with a view to being classed with the Bureau Veritas and that the work was nearly completed.

The Surveyors added that the Superintendent informed them that it was considered to be more advantageous to the Company to have their smaller vessels classed with the Bureau Veritas.

It is submitted the class of the vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
