Dear Sir,

We have from Messrs. Marius Nielsen & Son received a letter, copy of which we enclose, wherein they informed us, much to our surprise and regret, that the s.s. "SIGRID" is lying at Svendborg shipyard where, according to instructions from the owners' superintendent, she is being surveyed with a view to her being classed with Bureau Veritas, and that the work was nearly completed.

Both the managing director and the superintendent being away, we awaited the return of the latter, and had an interview with him, when he explained that there had been no difficulties whatever with our surveyors, that he had acted according to instructions from the managing director Mr. Marius Nielsen, and that it was considered to be more advantageous to the Company to have their smaller vessels classed with Bureau Veritas, and that steps had already been taken to have three

additional vessels transferred to Bureau Veritas, and that contracts with that Society to that effect had already been signed.

We have however induced the superintendent to defer action in the matter of the remaining vessels classed with our Society until the return of the managing director in about a month time.

We also enclose translation copy of a letter from the superintendent giving his reasons for the extraordinary proceedings of his Company.
