Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 27th ultimo, respecting the case of the steamer "JACQUES SCHIAFFINO", and may say that on the 15th ultimo the Society's Surveyors at Marseilles forwarded a letter from the Societe de Navigation a Vapeur Daher, of that port, stating that this vessel had been purchased by them and that they had decided to withdraw her classification from the Society's Register Book.

The Committee had the case before them on the 24th ultimo, when instructions were given for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

In this case, therefore, the withdrawal of the vessel's class would appear to be entirely due to the action of the new Owners.
