The S.S. No.2 (after an early No.3), due 8,28, has been partly held, and to complete same a bower anchor and 15 fathoms of chain cable require to be supplied.

In reply to enquiry the Gibraltar Surveyor stated on the 22nd ultimo that he was informed by the Owner's Agents that a quantity of stores and equipment had been waiting there for collection by the vessel for some time, but since the fall of the peseta the vessel had been working in and out of Seville, and it was stated that until the exchange improved the Agents did not expect the trawler to call at Gibraltar.

The case received the consideration of the Committee on the 9th instant when the Owner was informed that it was understood that the new equipment was awaiting the vessel at Gibraltar, but as no definite arrangements appeared to have been made for same to be placed on board, he was asked/<sup>to arrange</sup>for this to receive early attention in order to entitle the vessel to retain the figure "1" for equipment.

It was added that a record of B.S. 12,29 was recently assigned subject to about 40 screwstays in the boiler being renewed before the end of next month.

The Owner now forwards a letter which translated reads "Please
