With reference to your letter of the 18th ultimo and in confirmation of the telephonic conversation which took place between a Representative of this Society and your goodselves today, I beg to acquaint you that a report of an examination of the wood motorship "DUVALLA" by a Surveyor appointed by Lloyd's Agents at Monrovia has now come to hand.

I think it well to remind you, however, of the intimation contained in my letter of the 19th May last, viz:- That the class of this vessel has been omitted from the reprint of the Society's Register Book, and that the United States Trading Co., of Akron, Ohio were informed accordingly in a letter which was sent to them from this Office on the 24th April; ~~Essthat~~ to entitle the vessel to have her class reinstated in the Register Book it will be necessary for the Half Time Survey on the hull and the machinery to be carried out at a port where the Society has a Surveyor stationed and for a favourable report to be received.
