Dear Sirs,

H. With reference to your letter of the 19th November last addressed to the Society's Office at New York relative to the Wood Motorship "DUVALLA" I beg to remind you that in order to meet your convenience the Committee agreed at the beginning of December to the Screwshaft Survey and the Half Time Survey being postponed until the end of June next, subject to the vessel's hull and machinery being generally examined and favourably reported upon by a Surveyor to be appointed by Lloyd's Agents at Marshall Junk.

Lloyd's Agents were accordingly asked to appoint a Surveyor on receiving a request from you to do so and the Committee have had before them a letter from Lloyd's Agents, from which it appears that they have received no request from you or from your Agents to arrange for the carrying out of the requisite examination.

In these circumstances, the Committee regret they have no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be omitted from the reprint of the Register Book which is now taking place.
